Derek Smetham won the battle of the joint promoting clubs by a slender 6 seconds. Only the top 4 riders broke the magical 20mph mark (just), a terrific effort on this tough parcours. James Cartridge saw fit to reopen the debate about which bike is best, turning in a cracking time on his racy R3. Derek Smetham seemed to be riding some kind of lightened frankenbike, an older TT whip compared to his usual steed. Road bikes dominated the rest of the field with very few making any concession to aerodynamics. No one took up the challenge of riding fixed.

Lisa Greenfield was first lady with a very rapid time, also set on a road bike. Rob Gough – aka the King of Catford - was the second roadman home in 5th place overall, taking the spoils from his hill-climbing chum, Glyndwr Griffiths. Michael Murkin and Richard Turpin fought a battle royale for the v6 prize, with the former squeaking the win by 25 seconds. Bristol South took the team prize by a comfortable margin from Cadence RT.

Lastly, the Conyngres Cowshed Scout Hut is fast attaining a mythical status within cycling as the West DC's equivalent of the Roubaix Showers; a time to reflect on the solidarity shared with fellow survivors of the '5 Hills of Hell'.
